Notice of Error on Policies Maps

During the formal public consultation on the pre-submission version of the Embleton Parish Neighbourhood Plan, incorrect versions of the Policies Maps (dated 'December 2018') were inadvertently published on the Embleton Parish Council website. The correct versions of the Policies Maps (dated 'January 2019') were included at pages 35 - 37 in the pre-submission plan, the executive summary and in the background evidence report on settlement boundaries. Accordingly, an opportunity has already been given during the normal consultation period for comments to be made on the Plan as a whole. However, in order to correct the administrative error, the correct versions of the Policies Maps are now displayed on the Parish Council website: <https://northumberlandparishes.uk/embleton/documents>

Embleton Parish Council is now inviting representations specifically on this error. Any individual or organisation that may already have made representations need not repeat their comments since these will all be taken into consideration in reviewing the draft Plan. Only new comments on this specific error will be considered. Comments on this matter must be submitted before 5pm on Wednesday 31st July 2019.

The only difference between the versions of the policies maps relate to the **Settlement Boundaries**. These boundaries are shown as a thick black line on the Policies Maps.

There are 2 differences between each version of the Policies Maps:

- Embleton: Land to the south of the village in the vicinity of the Playing Field and Sports Pavilion; and
- Christon Bank: Land to the east of the B1340.

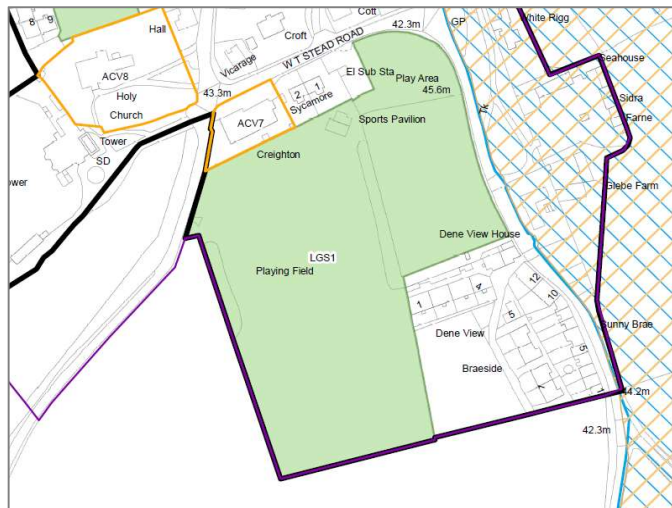
These differences are shown in the map extracts below. The keys for the maps remain unchanged.

Inset: Embleton Settlement

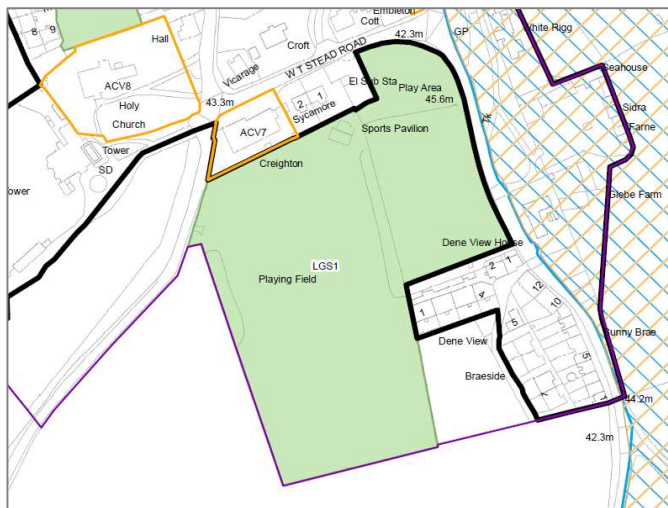
December 2018 (**incorrect version**)
